### Preamble

Following on-going collaboration since the signing of an initial Memorandum of Understanding in April 2006, FTN and LBFC have decided to renew their long term cooperation agreement.

Both parties recognized each other as a supportive strategic partner and would like to pursue with existing activities:

- Lafarge support to research projects lead by FTN,
- FTN assistance to Lafarge in development and testing of new products,
- Internship opportunities within LBFC
- Exchange of experience and knowledge were shared during conferences and symposiums

With a rising interest shared by both parties in the fields of sustainable construction and energy efficiency, it was decided to further direct this collaboration in this area, with the possibility of a joint research program involving scientists from both sides.

Government of the Auntonomy Province Vojvodina encourage and support this initiative. When relevant, actions stemming from this collaboration will be included within the framework of these institution strategic frameworks, such as research funding schemes and educational programs

## Results

Both parties strongly agree about pursuing their cooperation, each party contributing from its area of expertise in the fields of Construction, in particular Sustainable Construction, Environment, Logistics and Supply Chain and Human Resources/Education and Development.

It has been agreed on following start-up actions:

a) Both parties to select representatives as members of the "Steering Committee", that will be in charge of:

- Setting the strategic vision,
- Validating the project proposals
- Monitoring the progress achieved by the "Working group".

- Preparing project plans including human and financial resources needed.
- Coordinating with third parties (Ministry, Government, Partners, etc..)
- Devising a structured level of future actions and plans
- Reporting to the Steering Committee
